

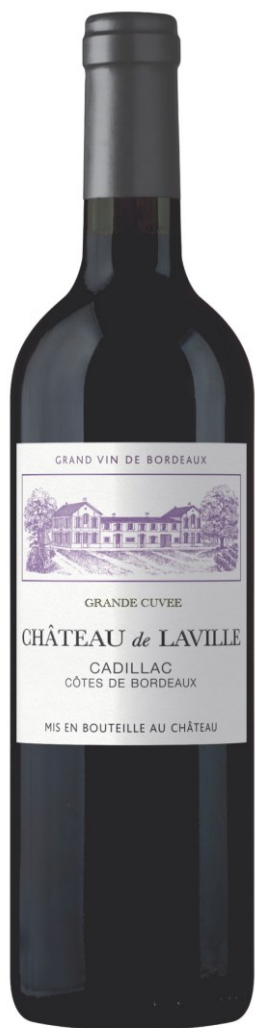


CHÂTEAU DE LAVILLE

CADILLAC CÔTES DE BORDEAUX



Château de Laville was acquired by Vignobles Gonfrier in 2019. Major work has been carried out to plant the vines at high density and to refurbish the wine-making cellar. Located in Capian, in the heart of our flagship appellation, this Château benefits from a singular terroir with hillside plots on a well-exposed clayey-gravelly ridge surrounding the beautiful charterhouse. It is located on a continental part of the appellation and therefore benefits from a cool climate. Its grape varieties with a majority of Cabernet Sauvignon confers it a beautiful structure.



A.O.C.: Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux

District: Capian

Vineyard surface area: 18 hectares

Terroir: Clayey-gravelly slopes

Grape varieties: 55% Cabernet Sauvignon
45% Merlot

Average vine age: 25 years

Viticulture: Traditional Bordeaux-style vine training, with two canes and a flat arch. Controlled grassing-down of the vine rows or mechanical working of the soil, to improve the soils' vitality and biodiversity. Manual "green harvesting", for a homogeneous distribution and proper aeration of the grape bunches. Mechanical grape harvesting.



The entire vineyard is managed using sustainable viticulture, certified as HVE3 (High Environmental Value), and we are committed to a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) approach certified by Ecovadis.

Vinification: Destemming, crushing and vatting. Fermentation in stainless-steel, temperature-controlled tanks. The terroir's quality allows for prolonged maceration to extract tannins of wonderful subtlety.

Ageing: 12 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting notes:

The wine is dark ruby with garnet highlights. The nose is marked by notes of spices and black fruit, notably blackcurrant, with a beautiful evolutionary note. The palate is well-balanced and long, with a mineral finish that gives this wine its distinctive complexity.
